

Congress has defined an intoxicating liquor to be any beverage containing one-half of one per cent, or more, of alcohol and this will go a long way to make the country dry in fact, as well as in name.

THE LEAGUE IS A REALITY

The League of Nations is an actmality. Representatives of France, Great Britain, Italy, Greece, Belgium, Spain, Japan, Portugal and Brazil met in Paris on the 16th and perfected the organization by the election of Leon Bourgeois, the French representative, chairman and Sir Eric Drum mond, of Great Britain, general secretary. The purpose of the League was declared to be "to promote international co-operation and to achieve international peace and secarity."


