Washington, D. C.—All records have been broken by the railways of the South in the movement of the high tide of commerce that continues throughout the territory served by them, according to figures, covering the movement of cars of commercial freight loaded during the six weeks' period from July eleventh to August twenty-first, announced today by the Car Service Commission of the American Railroad Association.

During each week of the six weeks' period there were loaded at stations on the railways of the South more cars of commercial freight than were loaded during the corresponding week of either nineteen nineteen or nineteen eighteen. The total number of cars loaded during the six weeks this year was 795,397 as against 716,294 for the same period in 1919 and 737,904 in 1918 when every nerve was strained to move the traffic incident to the war.

During the week ended August twenty-first there were loaded 137,937 cars at stations on the railways of the South as against 126,997 cars for the same week in 1919 and 124,175 cars for the same week in 1918.

During the first three weeks of August this year the total number of cars loaded on the railways of the South was 416,940 while during the last three weeks of July the number loaded was 378,457, showing an increase of 38,483 or over 12,000 cars per week for August over July, indicating a progressive improvement for this week as well as increases over last year and the year before.

From 1910 to May, 1918, freight rates decreased 4 per cent. From May, 1918, to December, 1919, freight rates increased 25 per cent.

From December, 1914, to December, 1919, the cost of material, equipment, and labor used by railroads increased tremendously. The following will illustrate this fact:
