The fundamental characteristics of Government Savings Securities are that they are safe beyond question easily convertible into money, and not subject to market fluctuations. Such merits give these securities a distinc tive investment value.

The securities are safe because they are guaranteed by the United States Treasury Department. They are easily convertible into cash, because they may be redeemed at local post offices or from the Treasury Department at Washington, and they are not subject to market fluctuations because the Treasury guarantees the price, which increases by a fixed amount-in the case of the interest-bearing securities -every month.

The \$5 War Savings Stamps cost from \$4.12 in January to \$4.23 in De cember, increasing in value one cent each month. The value of the \$25 Treasury Savings Certificate increases five cents a month, that of the \$100 certificates twenty cents a month, that of the \$1,000 certificates \$2 a month Like War Savings Stamps the certif icates are redeemable at their full face value upon maturity; that is in five years from the year of purchase.
