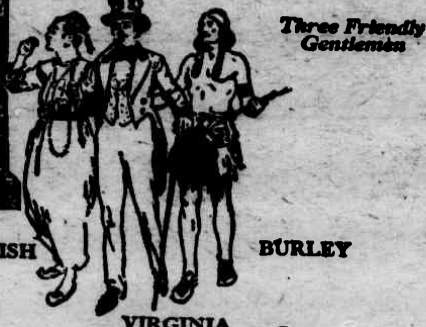

**NOTICE TO TEACHERS**

Please take notice that on the second Tuesday and Wednesday, April 11 and 12, there will be given an examination for Teachers Certificates in the office of the County Supt. of Transylvania County. The examination will open at 9 A. M. each day.

In regard to the examination will say that "Grammar Grade and Primary certificates, can no longer be obtained by examination. Applicants can obtain only the academic credits for the Elementary certificate of Class B and High School Teachers' certificates of Class C. In order to meet the professional requirements they must secure summer school credits."

The group plan will no longer be used. Applicants must stand on all subjects at the same examination period.

There has been a change in the subjects given in both the Elementary and High School examination. The examination is not based on any particular books. "In order to pass the elementary examination the applicant should have a knowledge of High School subjects." The High School Teachers' examination is based on the High School course and two years of college work.

All persons who are not thoroughly familiar with the high school subjects are discouraged from taking the Elementary examination.

Now, therefore, any and all teachers in Transylvania County who desire to better their professional standard and raise the value of their certificates, and at the same time increase their State rating, will please come on the aforesaid dates prepared to take examination for either an Elementary certificate or High School
