

THE ELEPHANTS ARE COMING

Circus Coming to Brevard—Kids Anticipate Big Day—See Big Parade

The M. L. Clark and Son's Combined Shows will exhibit in Brevard, Monday, September 11. The big show will arrive here aboard its special train of railroad cars, with all its magnitude and grandeur, revealing a fairyland ever so dear to childhood's happy days. Enlarged two fold of its former size, the M. L. Clark and Son's Shows has grown and prospered during the past quarter of a century, until today its appearance is hailed as an annual festive holiday.

Many new and unparalleled features of magnificence, novelty, daring and vastness will be displayed in this season's big show.
