The co-operation of women who are now entering fields of endeavor from which they have until now been barred, is already notable in its efficiency, and will continue to be more marked. The time is forever gone when the school will be a place in which the acquisition of the three "R's" is the sole object. The welfare of the individual as a whole will be the goal.

Subjects that have been in the past lightly treated, or ignored altogether, are now being viewed from their proper standpoint of value. This will become more essential as the years go by. In former days the comfort of pupils was little thought of. The one object was to accomplish the task assigned.

It was of little concern if the seat or desk fitted the occupant, whether the light was sufficient, or the water pure. It is beyond dispute that under such handicaps a wonderful race did develop. It is still true that "there is no royal road to learning," or for that matter anything worth while, but opportunities being greater, things should be in order.

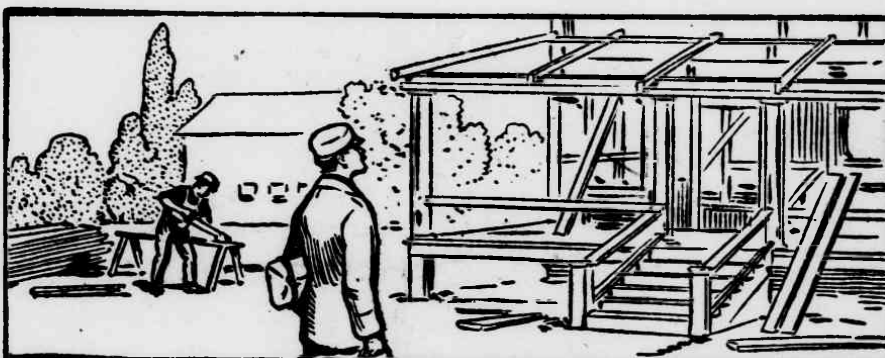
