The trees of Borneo, the Philippines and New Guinea, it is said, are valuable enough to pay the allied debt. There is the molave, which resists the sea slug and white ants, and the beautiful red and yellow narra (mabogany), the red assuming a deep lustrous wine color when it is immersed in salt water. There is bun, which makes fine masts, and dougan, which is the hardest wood known. There is balate, a sort of fig which grows around other trees, killing them, and feeding on the dead trunk until it is entirely consumed.

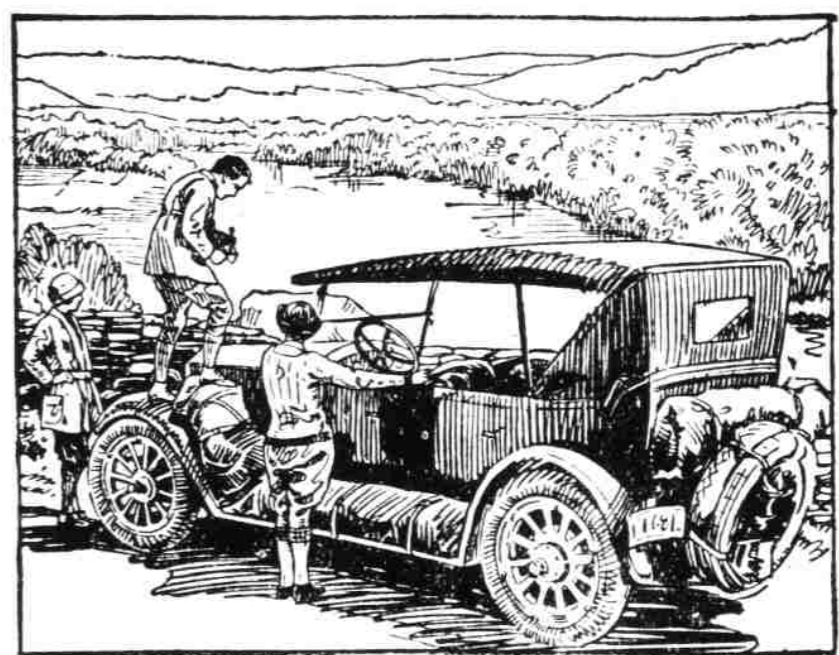
