Valuable Trees.

The trees of Borneo, the Philippines and New Guinea, it is said, are valuable enough to pay the allied debt. In these islands is the exquisite camagon, whose wood is yellow and black, like tortoiseshell. There is the molave, which resists the sea slug and white ants, and the beautiful red and yellow narra (mahogany), the red assuming a deep lustrous wine color when it is immersed in salt water. There is laun, which makes huge masts, and dungan, which is the hardest wood known. There is balete, a sort of fig which grows around other trees, killing them, and feeding on the dead trunk until it is entirely consumed.
