Duty of the Elder Generation to Provide for the Child an Education

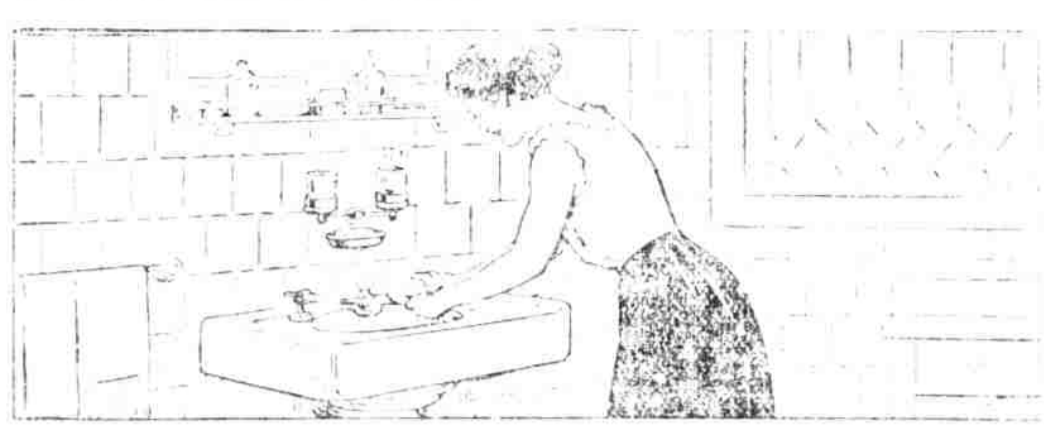

Great discoveries already have made physically possible universal comfort and refinement of life, though we are not yet skilled enough to insure equally those living conditions which may afford the children of every family a fair start in life. Our laws and actions lag behind the attainments science already has made possible. What is now almost common knowledge of the laws of health and sanitation fills volumes—what we neglect to do in obedience to these laws would fill larger volumes.

From the census of 1920, we learn that one-third of our population is under sixteen years—12,500,000 children are between ten years and fifteen. Of these 1,000,838 are at work and over one-third of all those at work are under thirteen years of age.

The theory of child-labor restriction is a doctrine which leads far. It applies to every child of every race. It tolerates no exceptions or exemptions from the duty of the elder generation to provide for every child an education which shall develop his powers and give him a fair chance in the world of tomorrow.
