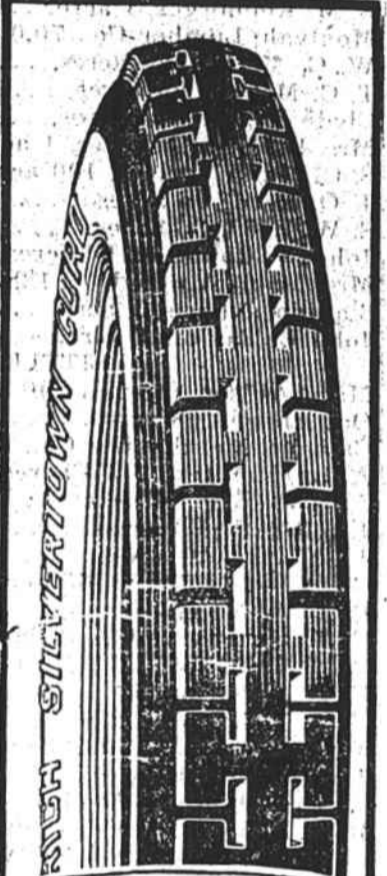
There is ample power for any and all occasions and it is believed that either mischievousness or criminal hatred is the cause of this miserable trickery.

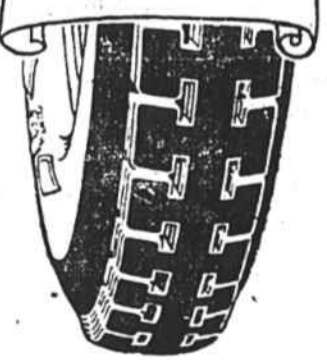
