Handy Things to Own

Costume Flowers



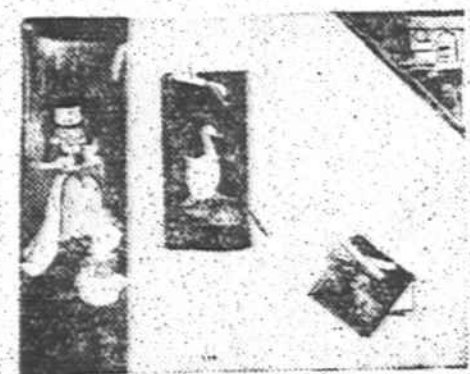

For Children's Desk



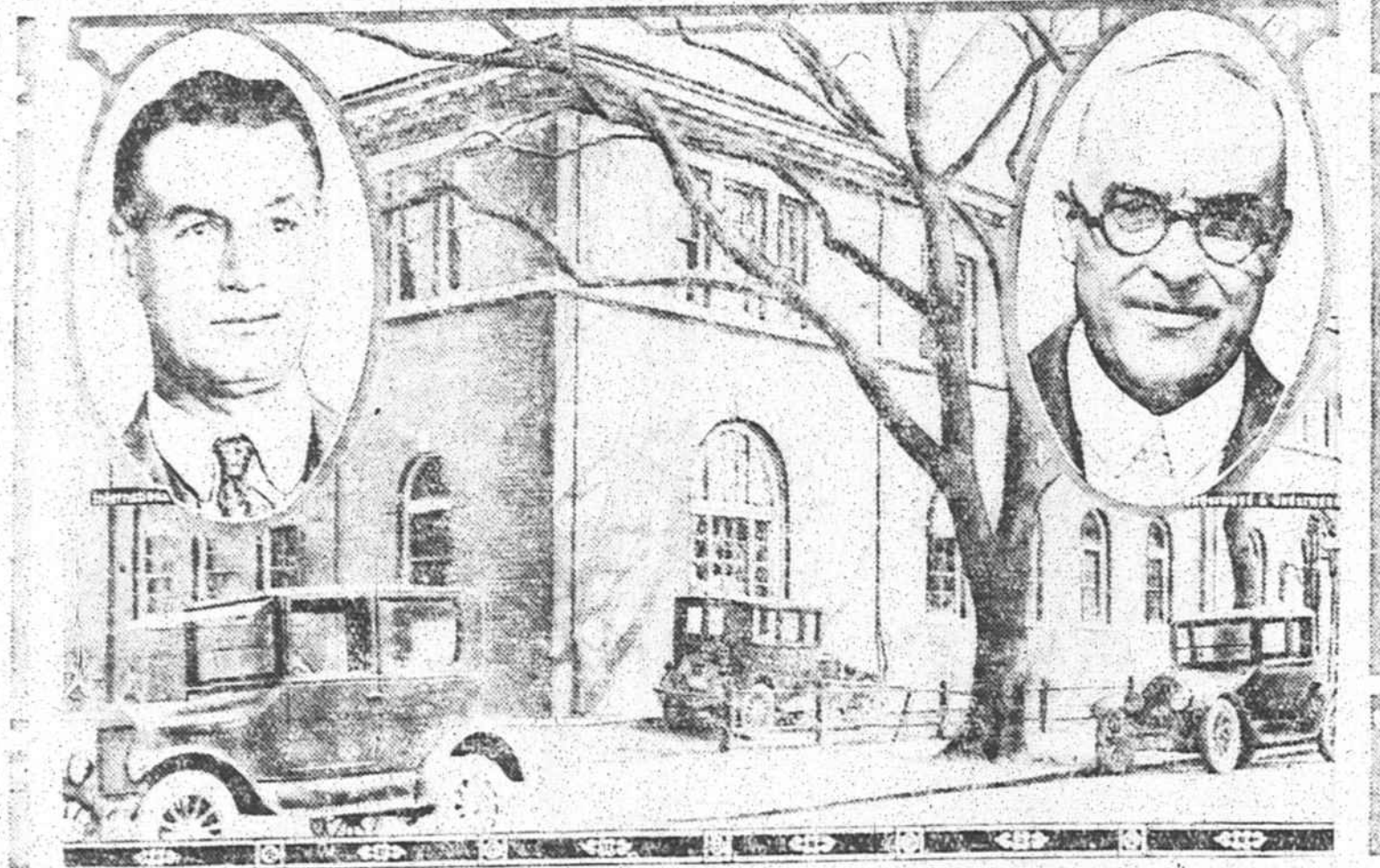

Where Court-Martial of Mitchell Is Being Held



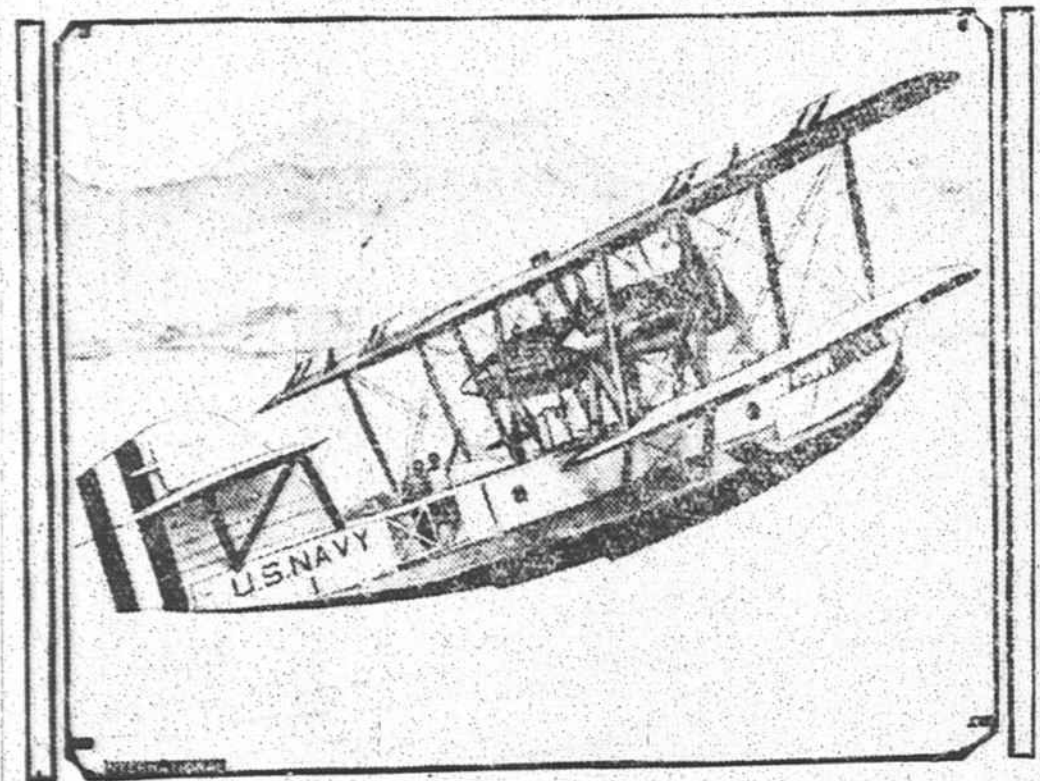
