crete bridge on Cherryfield Creek; thence with the center of the highway about South 10 deg. west 46 poles to a stake, the corner of a 4 acre tract; thence with the line of said 4 acre tract, south 87 deg. east 34 poles to a stake; thence south 3 deg. west 20 1-2 poles to a stake in the old Paxton line; thence with said old Paxton line south 87 deg. east 50 poles to a stake in the center of Cherryfield Creek, above the railroad bridge; thence up and with the center of Cheryfield Creek 110 poles more or less to a stake in junction of Cherryfield Creek and take notice than an action has been Masons Creek; thence up and with commenced in the Superior Court of the center of Mason's Creek north
