Chief attraction of the morning program was the concert of the Toy Symphony Orchestra, under the direction of Miss Clio Jamison, head of the Rosman Music department. The Toy Symphony Orchestra had 35 pieces, including bells, drums, etc.

Julian Glazener, head of the agriculture department of the Brevard High School, delivered an inspiring address at the morning assembly of the Rosman Fair.

The community booths were wonderful pictures of bounty and beauty. A fine spirit of friendly rivalry was in evidence. Mountain people are noted for their great community pride as well as their independence.

The exhibits at the Rosman Fair added another bright page to the history of celery growing in Transylvania county.
