

NOTICE OF SALE

North Carolina Macon County.

Whereas power of sale was vested in the undersigned trustee by deed of trust from Meriwether and McCannack Investments, Incorporated, dated 5 day of April, 1926, and registered in the office of the Register of Deeds for Macon County in Book N-4 of Deeds, page 172, to secure the payment of three notes of even date with said deed of trust, said notes being for \$19.50, \$109.50, and \$1209.50 and payable one, two and three years from the date of said deed of trust respectively, and said deed of trust and notes stipulated that in case default should be made in the payment of either of said notes or interest thereon, that all of said notes should at once become due and payable whatever might be the date of maturity expressed therein.
