

### Meetings Set To Study Tax Relief

In an interview with J. Frazier Glenn, executive secretary of the North Carolina Property Tax Relief association, he says there will be a state meeting held at the county court house at Greensboro, at 11 o'clock Tuesday, July 1, 1930, at which time matters of very great importance regarding the plan for tax reduction on property in North Carolina will be discussed by able speakers.

Judge Glenn said that he expected a very large attendance from practically every county in the state; that in the majority of the counties there had already been organized County Tax Relief associations, which are co-operating heartily with the State organization; that meetings in the respective counties where organizations

are now functioning would be held at 12 o'clock noon at the court house in the respective counties on Saturday, June 28, 1930 for the purpose of electing delegates to the state meeting at Greensboro and for the purpose of considering such other matters as the county association desires to consider.

It is requested that meetings be called at the court house in all the other counties of the state at 12 o'clock noon on Saturday, June 28, 1930, for the purpose of perfecting organizations in said counties and selection of delegates to the state meeting at Greensboro.


