### City League Games Played Last Week

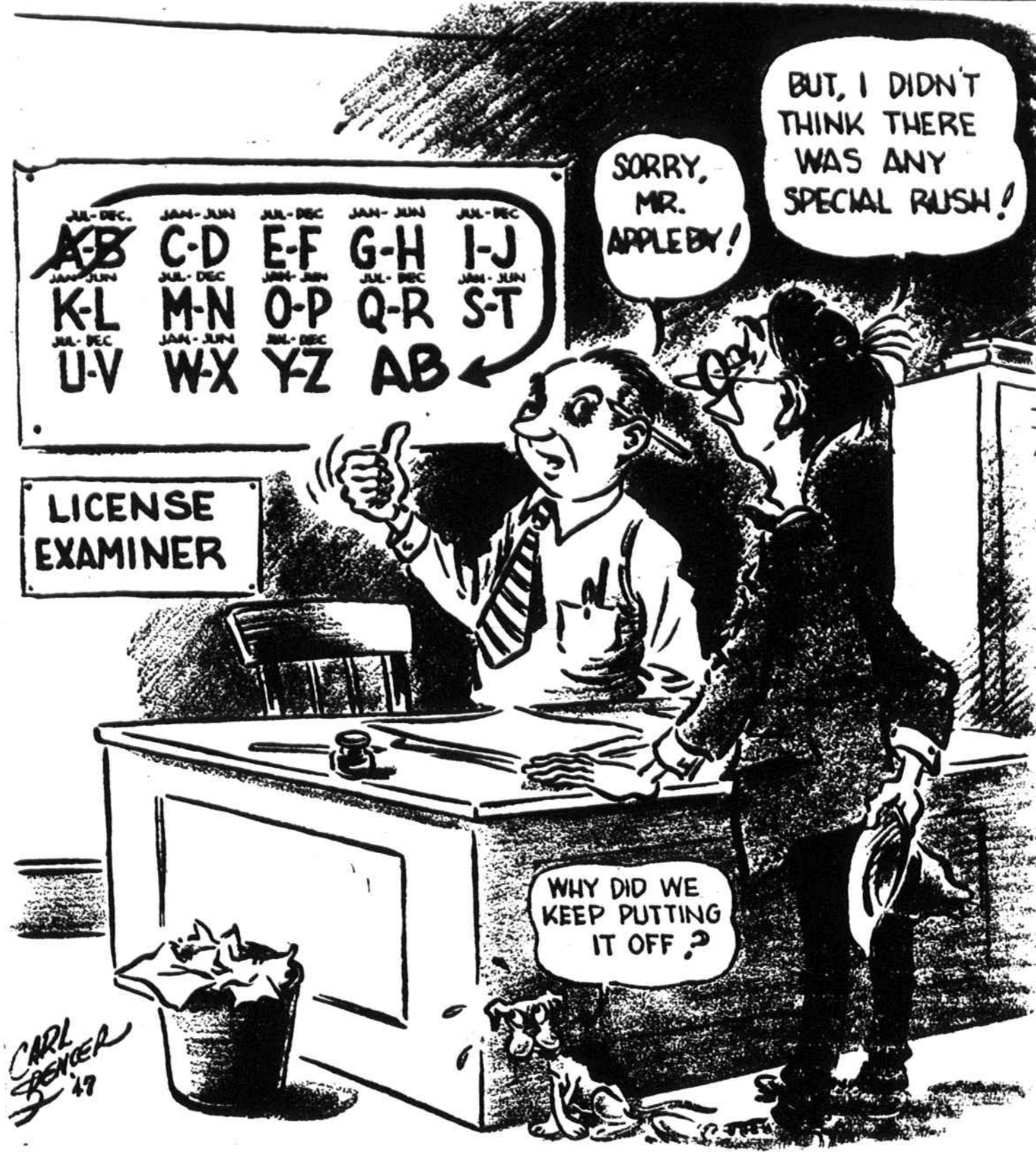

October milk production on United States farms this year totaled 8.9 billion pounds, slightly lower than in the 1944-46 period but higher than in previous years.

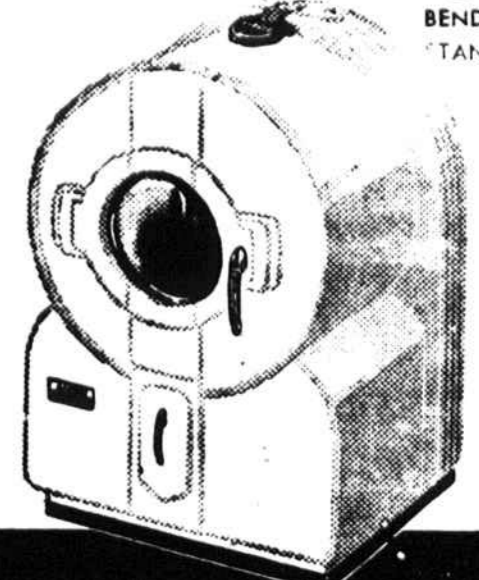
The U. S. Department of Agriculture has announced that approximately 43,107,000 bushels of United States grain and grain products were exported in October proximately 1947.

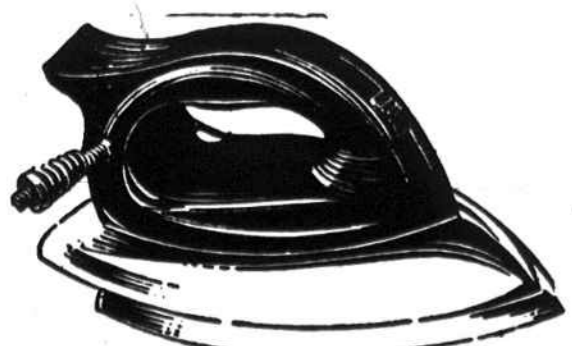
