

"Concern over the low stock position would be greater were it ot for the indicated favorable rops for the 1948-49 season," the Fat Salvage Committee explains Besides the hundreds of indusrial channels into which used fats go, this additional 100 to 200 milion pounds of household fat salaged each year serves the naional economy by making availble greater amounts of other kinds of fats including vital food fats.

Illustrative of the significant ontribution made by household at salvage is a statement by Chas. Lund, Associate Director, Food 3ranch, Office of International rade of the Department of Comnerce: "This reclamation of used ts, between 100 to 200 million ounds a year . . . reduces the ossible use of lard (for example) ith its resultant increased de-



oils in the U.S. in the 1947-48, "stocks of fats and oils in the U. S. have continued to decline and at the end of May 1948 totaled 1,416 million pounds." This figure is 139 million pounds less than May 1946 and only 246 million pounds more than the record low of recent years reached in Octoer 1946, the Fat Salvage Commitse points out.
