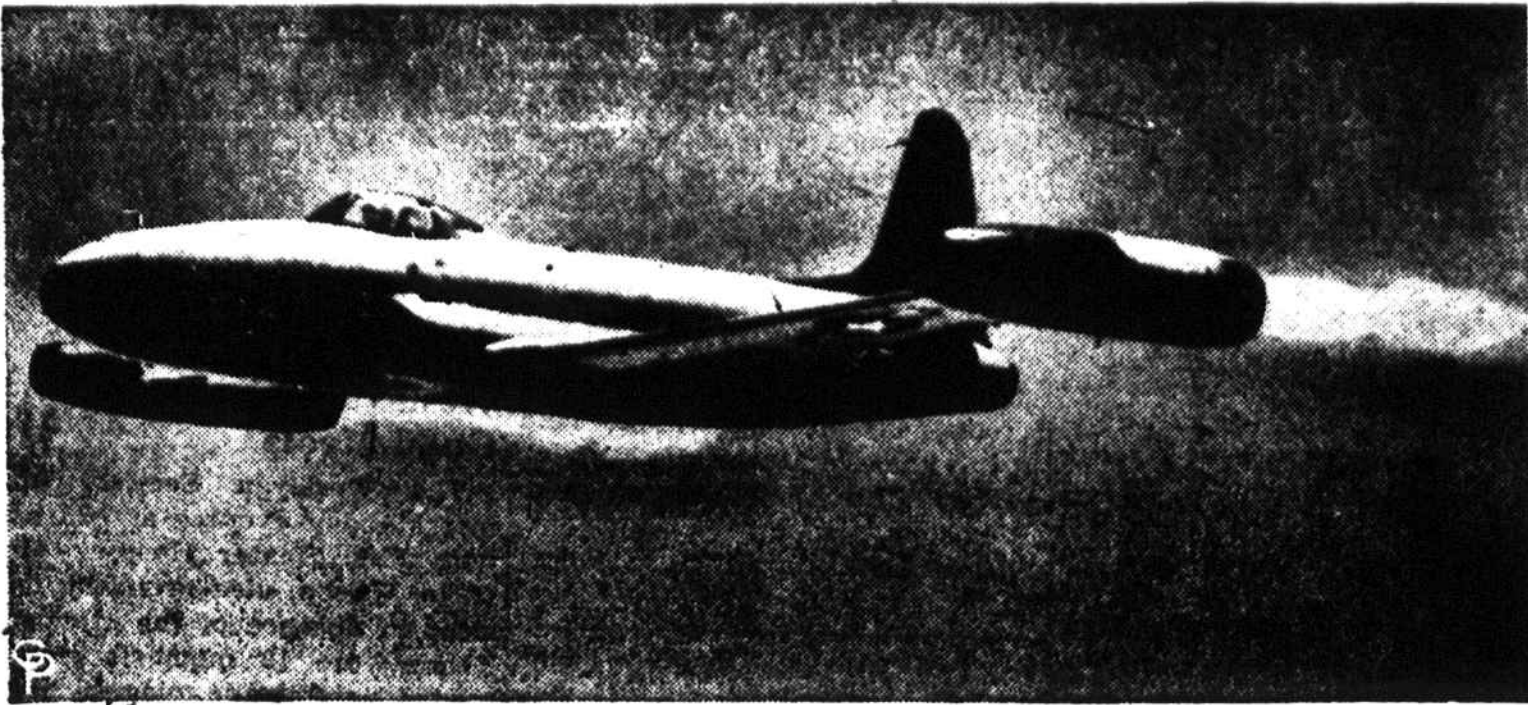


THE AIR FORCE RAM-JET STREAKS THROUGH THE SKY

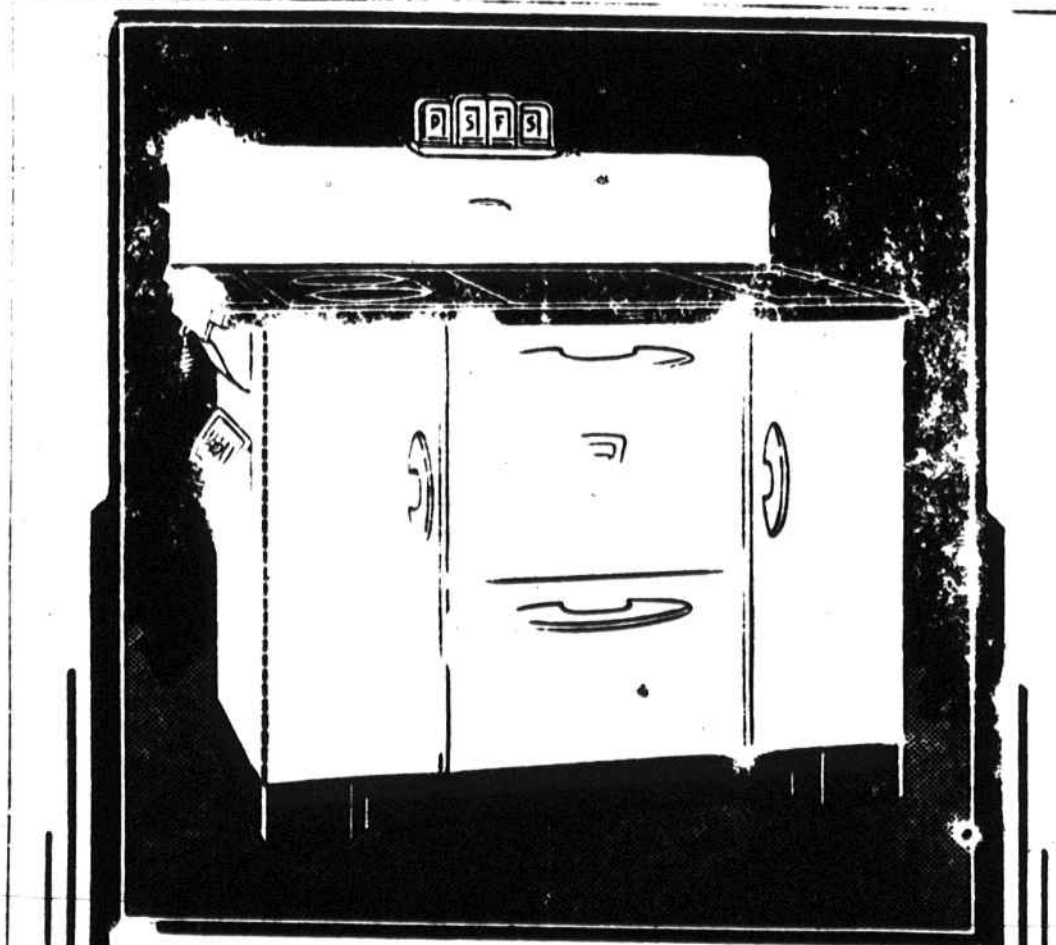
