**DIRECTIONAL SIGNS BEING PUT UP BY SYLVA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

Several large signboards have been placed on highway approaches to Sylva recently by the Chamber of Commerce in an effort to publicize Sylva's tourist business and increase the number of tourists visiting the town.  
 The two newest signs are those near Cashiers, located on the Rosamond highway and on the Highlands highway, so placed as to be noticed by tourists coming toward Sylva. The two signs are ten feet by twelve and are not yet finished. Construction has been finished but painting has not yet been completed. Recently there was also constructed a larger sign at Ela.  
 Erection of the signboards is a part of the Chamber of Commerce's effort to increase the use of tourist facilities in Sylva and Jackson county. Circulation of the printed pamphlet prepared by the group concerning Jackson county is a

large part of the program involved. The Chamber of Commerce office on Main Street, under the direction of Mrs. John R. Jones, is continually mailing out these bulletins to prospective tourists and to tourist agencies. In addition there has been compiled a printed list of tourist facilities in the county which is also distributed.  
 The number of tourists in western North Carolina is higher than that of last year, when the epidemic of polio sharply decreased the number who had been expected. The object of the Chamber of Commerce organization is to bring a larger percentage of those visiting this section to Sylva and Jackson county.  
 Two-thirds of farm dwellings in the United States do not have running water, while only 4.5 per cent of city dwellings are without it.

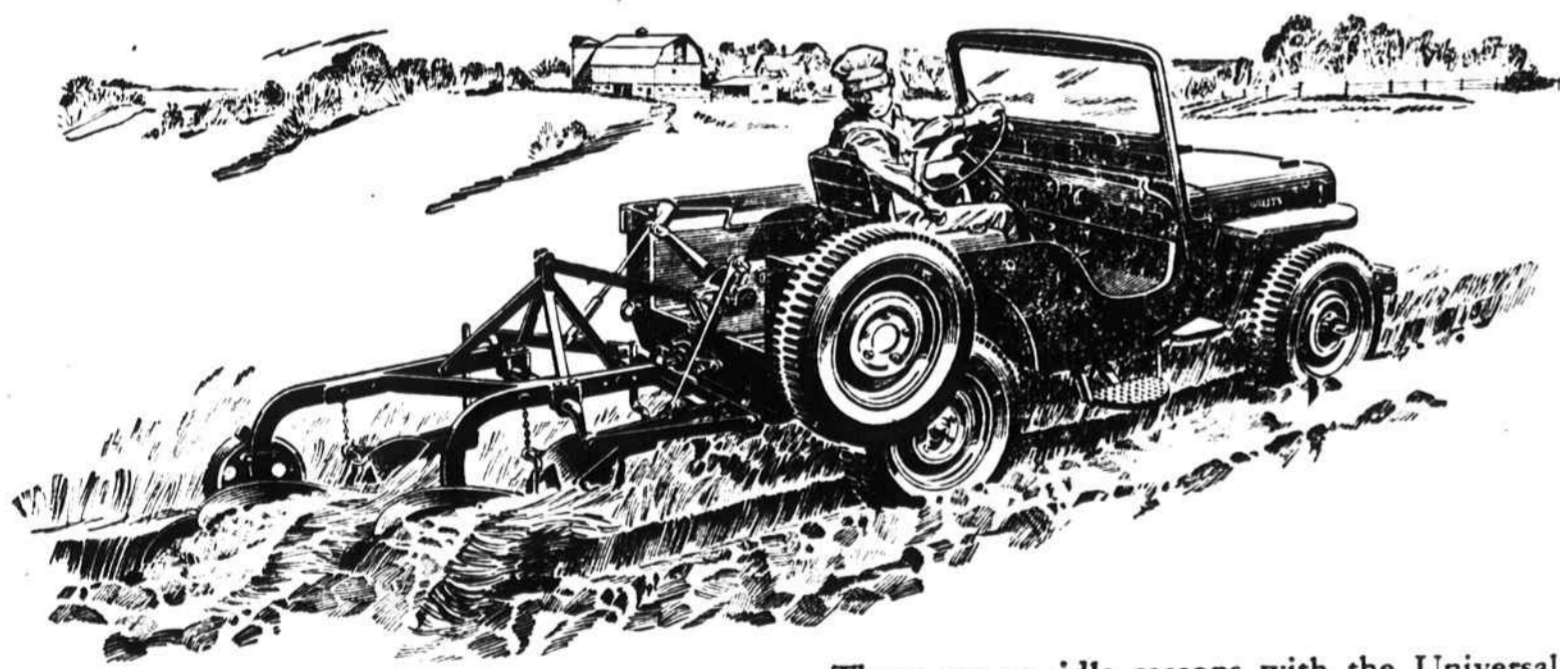
