NOTICE North Carolina Madison County Entry 1211. To Z. G. Sprinkle, Reg. Of Deeds for Madison County, and Ex-Officio Entry Taker for Madison County, N. C. The undersigned Z. V. Fisher of Madison County, N. C. Enters and lays claim to the following described piece of parcel of land situated in No. 9 township, Madison County, State of N. C., the same being vacated and unappropriated lands and subject to entry to wit: Lying between Spring Creek and French Broad River above Hot Springs, beginning at a stake on the South side of Spring Creek opposite a large rock just above where the old road crosses the said creek at the foot of long Mountain and at the Northwest of the Dutchman bottom and where the Stokley Donaldson line crosses the said creek; thence running East with the Stokley Donaldson line 130 chains to a stake in the mountain Island branch; thence South 110 chains to a stake at the beginning corner of the Stokley Donaldson grant; thence East 40 chains to a stake; thence North 50 East 80 chains, thence North 160 chains to the French Broad River; thence down the French Broad River to the railroad iron bridge, where it crosses the French Broad River just above Hot Springs, thence west 60 chains to Spring Creek; thence up Spring Creek to the beginning containing by estimate one thousand and five hundred acres (1500).
