Stop On Dual Roads For School Buses

Raleigh — The Motor Vehicles Department explained today that traffic on both sides of a dual, or separated thoroughfare, must come to a standstill when approaching a stopped school bus.

The memo was issued to clarify some confusion whether motorists are required to stop, as on a conventional highway, slow down or keep going.

The agency admitted there was little danger to children discharged from a bus on a dual highway separated by an "island." But under current laws, unchanged so far by the General Assembly, traffic both ways must stop irrespective of highway layout.

urged motorists to keep a sharp lookout for school buses loading or unloading passengers. "Drivers of school buses are trained to display proper signals when preparing to stop," he said. "It's up to the motorist to recognize and obey these signals and to act accordingly."
