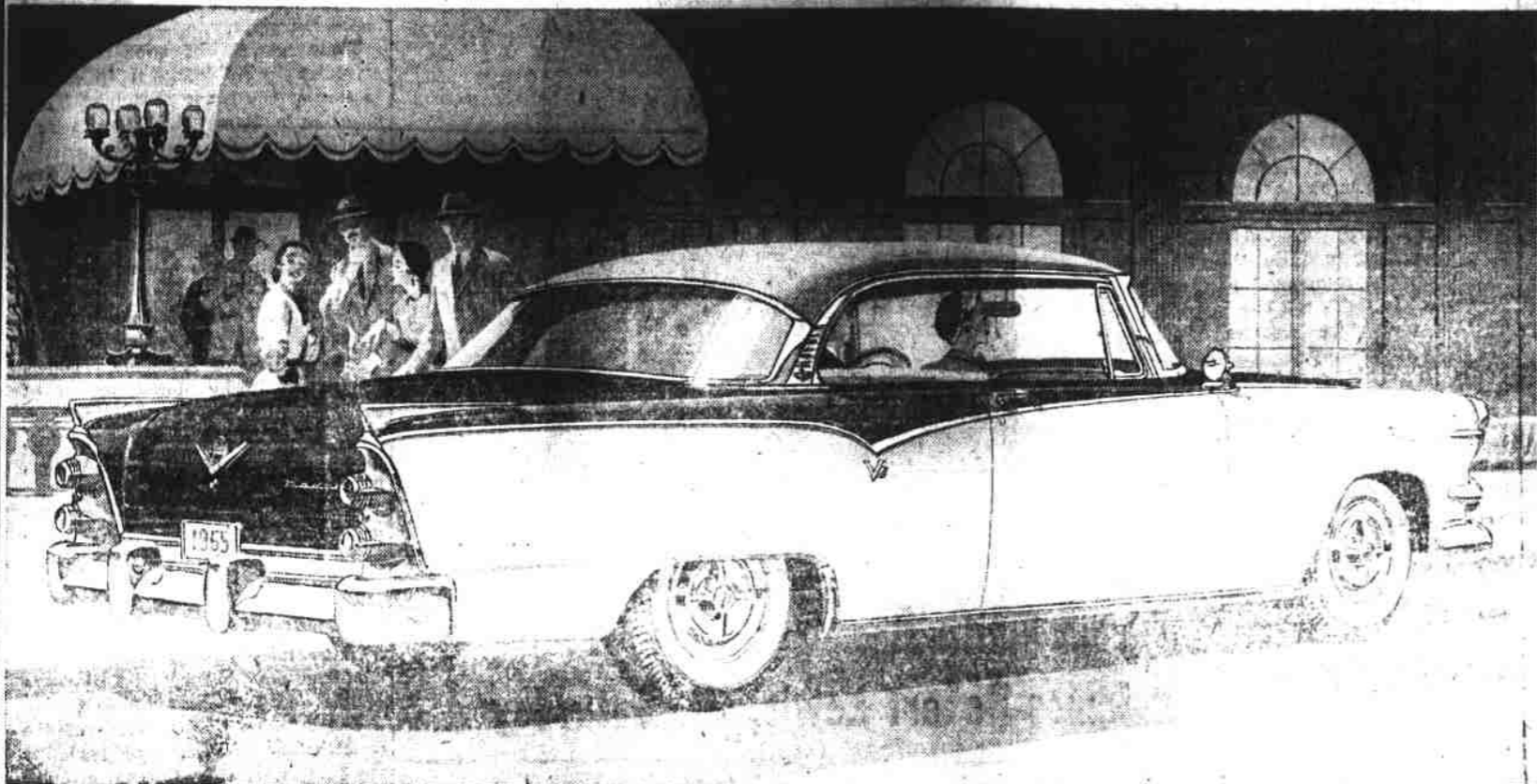

The nature of the relief being sought is as follows:

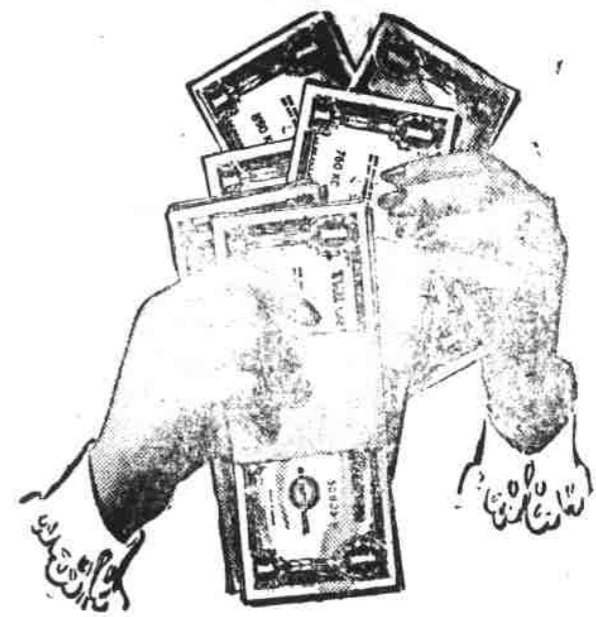
