Greensboro, Feb. 7 - Consolidated net sales of \$179,280,000 ter the 3 months ended December 31, 1955, were reported today by Burlington Industries, Inc. These sales compare with \$127,392,000 for the quarter ended January 1, 1955.

Net earnings during the quarter ended December 31, 1955 were \$8,-218,000 after deducting income taxes of \$6,867,000 and minority interests in earnings of \$1,113,000. Included in net earnings were non-recurring profits of \$3,666,000, or \$.15 per share, realized on sales of fixed assets and investments. The balance of net earnings of \$4,552,000 were \$.51 per share after preferred dividends and represented profits from operations, including Pacific Mills




