 immunized against diphtheria, whooping cough and typhoid and revealed that in 1957, the number of immunizations against polio totaled 2,003.

He also gave other interesting statistics, bearing out the ever increasing services of the department.

Dr. Higgins spoke of the unique way Dr. Margery J. Lord, County Health Officer, got things done and commended her for her many worthwhile objectives and accomplishments.

Following Dr. Higgins' address, Dr. Ramsey introduced W. W. Peek, superintendent of schools and a member of the county board of health. Mr. Peek spoke briefly on what the Public Health programs meant to the school-age children and praised the work of the personnel.

Following the program, citizens were shown through the building. Every room was decked with baskets of beautiful flowers sent the department by firms and individuals for the dedication.

There are 250 members of the Madison County Bureau at present and the goal for the coming year has been set at 300. Farm organization is becoming more important and Farm Bureau fills a need across the Agricultural Board.
