second and third highest number of votes will be vice chairman and regular member respectively, of the community committee and alternate delegates to the county convention.

Following the community elections the chairmen of the newly elected community committees will meet at the county convention to be held September 20 to elect the county ASC committee for the coming year.

The county committee, which also consists of 3 members and 2 alternates, serves as a "Board of

Directors" for the county office and has general responsibility for administering the various agricultural programs enacted by Congress. These include the Agricultural Conservation Program, Production Adjustment, Price Support, Feed Grain and other programs. Since the committeemen will assume important responsibilities, serious consideration should be given in voting.

All newly elected committeemen will take office October 1.

In conclusion, Ramsey said every farmer should use his or her right to vote and urged voters to mark and return their ballots by the closing date of September 10.
