"Domestic use fo both flue-cured and burley is expected to increase two to three per cent in 1962-63 as a result of the increase in cigarette consumption," said Allgood.

"Exports in 1962-63 are expected to remain at the 1961-62 level. But there may be a slight decrease within the next few years because of trade barriers," he ad-

"Prices are expected to remain steady to slightly higher depending upon the export situation in the next three to five years."
