riod increased by 10 million pounds over the previous year

"Domestic use of both flue-cured nearly three per cent and exports by about 10 per cent above 1960-61.

"Domestic use of both flue-cured and burley is expected to increase two to three per cent in 1962-63 as a result of the increase in cigarette consumption," said Allgood.

"Exports in 1962-63 are expected to remain at the 1961-62 level. But there may be a slight decrease within the next few years because of trade barriers," he added.

"Prices are expected to remain steady to slightly higher depending upon the export situation in the next three to five years."
