Camp Friendship, Thailand — (AHTNC) — Army Pfc. Kenneth

A. Gosnell of Marshall, recently returned to his home station at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, with other members of the 95th Infantry's 1st Battle Group after receiving three months of counter-insurgency and guerrilla warfare training in the jungles of Thailand.
