In a fund. ness of life. amental sense the mode of the Resurrection cannot be stated. The early church was aware of this difficulty. The New Testament describes Jesus' Resurrection in two ways. This Jesus who was resurrected, recognized, and talked with was the pre-Crucifixion Jesus. And yet he wasn't "physical" in the ordinary sense. He could appear and disappear; he could walk into locked rooms; and he even remained unknown sometimes, as on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:16). Paul described the condition of Resurrection as a "spiritual body." The two words, spirit and body, indicate contradictory categories. But then the Resurrection does not fit into ordinary categories. One can therefore appreciate the dilemma of the disciples. The Resurrection is beyond the dimensions of our usual areas of knowledge. Yetthe One who was crucified has been raised. Sin and death have defeated. Jesus is alive. God has triumphed!
