Much In Demand At Square Dances; Started As Youngsters

Leader Of Band

Music is the middle name of the three sons of Mr. and Mrs. R. G. Hunter, of Mars Hill. For many years their string music has been heard throughout Madison County and more recently in Philadelphia, Pa., where the three brothers, aided by Obray Ramsey, well-known county musician, performed at the Philadelphia Folk Festival on September 10-11.

It all started out years ago when Tommy started strumming a fiddle with great skill. He soon interested his two other brothers, Jerry and Stanley, in string music and before too long they were known as the Hunter Brothers Band. Jerry decided that the bass fiddle was his instrument and Stanley picked up a guitar and before long was letting out with pretty music. It was also discovered that Stanley had a good voice with a wide range. Hence, he took over the chores of singing in addition to the guitar.

Tommy was not satisfied to just lay around the county and play his fiddle, so he graduated from the National Radio Institute of Washington, D. C.

they include folk, country, "pop," western swing, blue grass, and religious music in their repertoire. They are much in demand at square dances and other types of entertainments and have also made many recordings and also appeared on radio.

**TWO MINUTES WITH THE BIBLE**

SIMPLE AS CAN BE

Have you ever heard some preacher say: "There are some things in the Bible which are hard to understand but, thank God, the plan of salvation is as simple as can be."

Well the plan of salvation IS simple IF we obey II Timothy 2:15, "rightly dividing the Word of Truth." Otherwise it is far from simple.

The Apostle Paul wrote: "We conclude that a man is justified by faith without the works of the Law" (Rom. 3:28). Yet James wrote: "By works a man is justified, and not by faith only" (James 2:24).

Again, at Sinai God said to Israel through Moses: "IF YE WILL OBEY MY VOICE INDEED, and keep My covenant, then shall ye be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people..." (Ex. 19:5). But our Lord said, as He sent His apostles to witness for Him that, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved... and these signs shall follow them that believe: in My name shall they cast out demons, they shall speak with new tongues..." etc. Thus, according to their "great commis-

sion" water baptism was required for salvation and miraculous signs were the evidence of salvation.

Confusing? Contradictory? Not if we "rightly divide the Word of truth." It was AFTER "the law was given by Moses," AFTER our Lord's earthly ministry, AFTER the commission to the twelve, that God raised up another apostle, Paul, and sent him forth with "the gospel of the grace of God" (Acts 20:24).

It was Paul who was sent to declare: "But NOW, the righteousness of God without the law is manifested..." (Rom. 3:24). "To him that worketh not, but believeth on Him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness" (Romans 4:5). "Therefore, being justified by faith we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Rom. 5:1).
