

for. Section 2. In order to raise the money required to finance the cost of erecting said new consoli-dated high school building, and of acquiring land and furnishings and equipment and apparatus nec-essary for such new building, bonds of the County of Madison are hereby authorized and shall be issued, pursuant to The Coun-ty Finance Act of North Caroli-na. The maximum aggregate prin-cipal smount of said bonds author-ized by this Bond Order shall be Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000). Section 3. A tax sufficient to pay the principal of said interest on said bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected. Section 4. A statement of the County debt. of the County of Madison has been filed with the Clerk of the Board of Commis-sioners of said County and is op-en to public inspection. Section 5. This Bond Order shall take affect when approved by the votors of the County at an elec-tion as provided in said act. The foregoing Bond Order has been introduced and a sworn state-ment has been filed under The County Finance Act, showing the assessed valuation of the County file
