YOUR LIFE INSURANCE

Q. In the policy I took out ten years ago, when I was still married, I remember making my son the "contingent beneficiary." That means he collects if the contingency, my death, comes to pass, right?
A. No, no.

If he's the contingent beneficiary, it means that he collects only if, at the time of your death, the person you've named primary beneficiary is no longer alive.

If you named your former wife, by name, as your primary beneficiary, then she is still your beneficiary even though she's no longer your wife!

To prevent situations like this, in which the insurance being carried is different from what the insured wants to carry (or even thinks he's carrying) it's a good idea to haul out your insurance policies once a year and go over them with a life insurance agent.

General Revenue Sharing provides federal funds directly to local and state governments. Your government must publish this report advising you how these funds have been used or obligated during the year from July 1, 1973, thru June 30, 1974. This is to inform you of your government's priorities and to encourage your participation in decisions on how future funds should be spent.

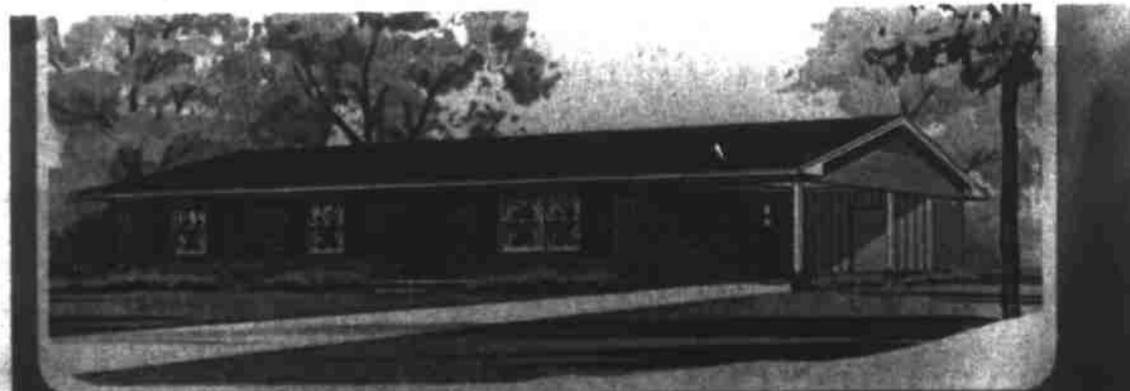
