Jim is such a super hitter that opposing teams try to stop him anyway they can. They often make up a special four-man outfield. But nothing seems to work.

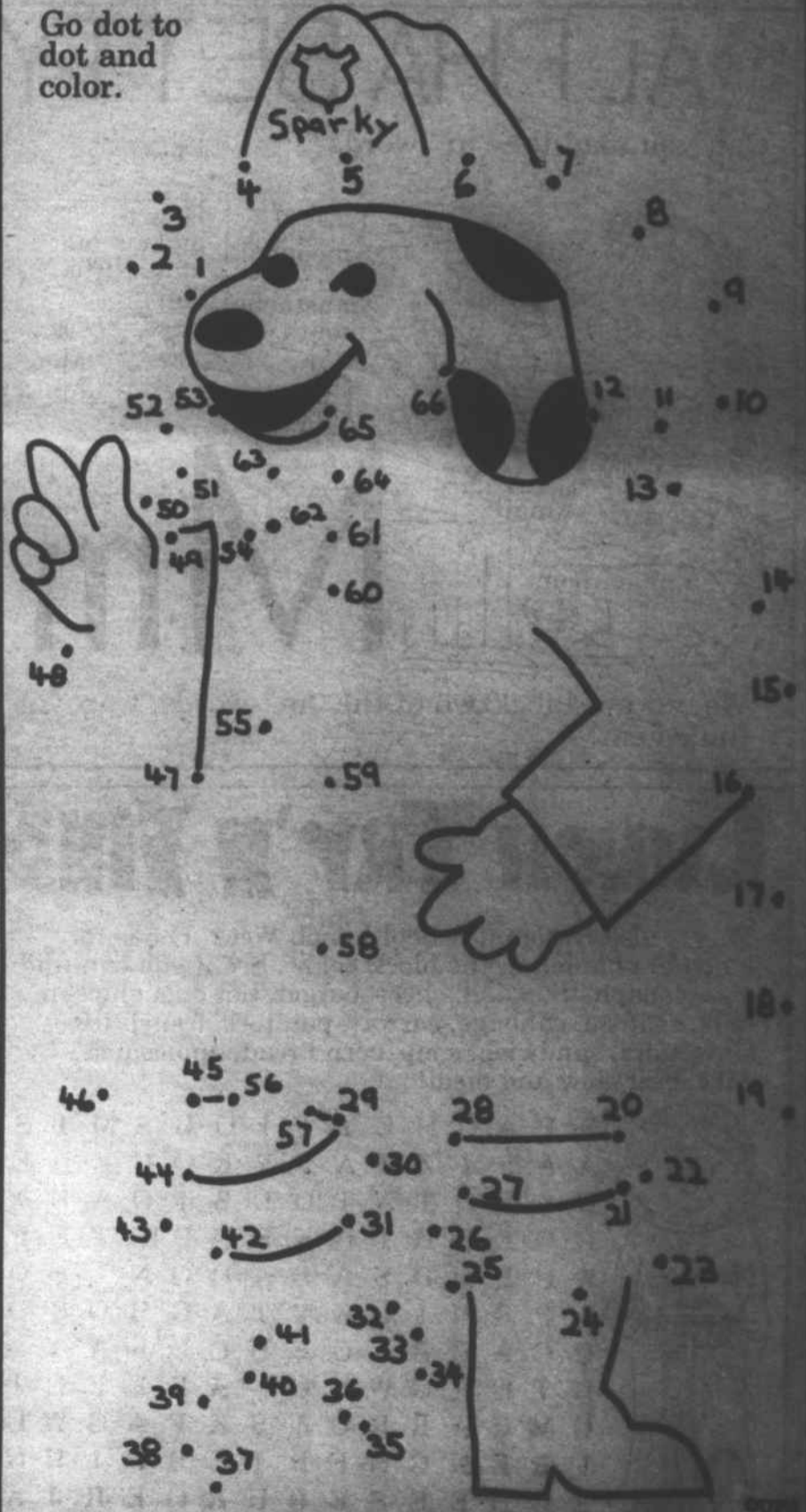
Jim is 25 years old. He has played for the Red Sox for four seasons.
