

Mars Hill Christmas Schedule

Administrative offices at Mars Hill College will close at 5 p.m. Dec. 22 for the Christmas holidays. Semester examinations end Dec. 17, and the residence halls will close at noon on Friday.

The office will reopen Jan. 3 at 8 a.m. The residence halls will reopen Jan. 7 at 2 p.m. while registration and schedule adjustments will be held from 9 a.m. to noon on Jan. 8. The January Short Term will end on Jan. 26.

Spring semester will begin on Jan. 29 with registration and schedule corrections and classes will begin at 8 a.m. on

Jan. 31.

Registration for the Spring Semester of Continuing Education Program (CEP) courses will be held Jan. 2 through 13. Specific dates and times for each CEP site will be announced later. Classes will be held Jan. 15 through May 10.

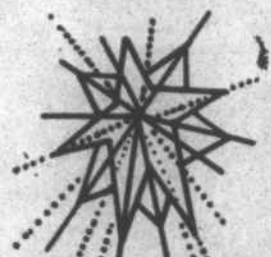
