

Play Ball!

Professional baseball teams are made up of players who play for money.

The 26 major pro baseball teams are divided into two leagues, the American League and the National League. Each league is divided into two divisions.

During the baseball season that begins in April, each team plays 162 games. They play only those teams in their own league. At the end of the season each league has a play-off between division winners.

The winner of the American League pennant, or title, then plays the winner of the National League pennant.

This best-of-seven series is called the World Series. The first team to win four games becomes the world champion.

Last year the Pittsburgh Pirates beat the Baltimore Orioles.

Pitch, Hit and Run Awards

"Pitch, Hit and Run" is a baseball competition for 8- to 12year-old boys and girls.

Thousands of players compete in local contests across the country. The finals were held in Cooperstown, New York, the home of the Baseball Hall of Fame, on Sept. 27.

This year's awards will be presented on the field just before the second game of the World Series.

One of the 1979 winners in the Pitch, Hit and Run contest was the first girl ever to win a championship. Crystal Fields of Cumberland, Maryland, was the champ in the 11-year-old group.
