Reward Offered

Rewards of up to \$500 will be paid for information leading to the conviction of any person or persons who poach wildlife and/or set fires in Great Smoky Mountains National Park, according to Chief

Ranger Richard Moeller. He said, many animals can be available to legal hunters when they move outside the protection of the Park but the number is reduced by the poachers who steal them. Con-

sequently, both the Park and the licensed legal hunter are victimized, as the result of poaching activities. "We lose not only the resource, but the thousands of taxpayer dollars needed for fire suppression. The arsonist, therefore, is also a thief who steals from everyone." Persons contributing information can do so anonymously and procedures are established for paying reward money without disclosing identities, according to Moeller.
