### Richardson To Address

### Warren Wilson Seminar

Former cabinet member and ambassador to Great Britain Elliot Richardson will speak at Warren Wilson College this weekend as part of the annual Southeastern World Affairs Institute. Richardson's address, on the U.S. stake in international lawmaking, will be presented Saturday at 7:45 p.m. in the college chapel in Swannanoa.

Sponsored by the American Freedom Association, the three-day seminar begins on Friday at 10:30 a.m. and will conclude on Sunday at noon. The annual meeting presents a series of panel discussions on international issues. The association will present its annual World Peace Award on Saturday night following Richardson's address.

Dr. Charles Milford of Charlotte will moderate the conference. Other participants and panelists will include Dr. Robert Bowman, director for the Institute of Space and Security Studies in Washington; Dr. Harold White, Jr., professor of space law and policy at UNC-Chapel Hill and William and Ann Wood of Charlotte.
