Public Notice of intent to issue a State NPDES permit
to the following:
1. Carolina Power and Light Company, Marshall
Hydroelectric Plant, Madison County, NPDES No.
NC0027545 (modification and renewal) There are
three discharges of (1) treated wastewater from an
air/water separator, (2) stormwater and (3) non-
contact cooling water into the French Broad River
located on NCSR 1001 (Radmond Road) at the French
Broad River.

2. Kiri Tamm-Adam, KNK Health Care, Madison Coun-
ty, NPDES No. NC0062947 (new.) There is one pro-
posed discharge of treated domestic wastewater into
Wilson Branch located on NCSR 1504 approximately
1.0 miles from its intersection with NCSR 1503 near
Ebb Chapel.

On the basis of preliminary staff review and application
of Article 21 of Chapter 143, General Statutes of North
Carolina Public Law 92-500 and other lawful standards
and regulations, the North Carolina Environmental
Management Commission proposes to issue a permit
