

The trailer home of William Thomas on the Marshall By-pass was also raided and Thomas was charged with the possession for sale of tax-paid alcoholic beverages without obtaining permits and license. Based on witnesses reports, Vaughn Franklin, 67, was charged with two counts of sale of tax-paid alcoholic beverages, dating back to March 7. Cathy Thomas, 33, was also charged with a previous sale of alcoholic beverages, dated Feb. 8.

Four others were charged with playing a game of chance (poker) in which money was bet. Those four were: Mike Lee Haynes, 79; Edison Andrew Hensley, 67; Robert M. West, age not given; and Franklin D. Shelton, 26; all of Marshall.
