suspension for five years.

As a result of the plea arrangement, Lorenz agreed to waive any deportation proceedings and agreed that he would not return to the United States, Baker said.

Allen ordered that Lorenz be held in Madison County Jail until he is placed in the custody of the U.S. Immigration Service for deportation.

In other action this week in Madison County Superior Court, Micheal Dean Ledford, who had been charged with possession of stolen property, pleaded guilty to

misdeemeanor possession of stolen property.

He received a two-year suspended sentence and was ordered to pay restitution to Marshall Farm & Garden.

Earl Eugene Spangler, charged with possession of a controlled substance with intent to sell and breaking and entering, pleaded guilty to misdemeanor possession of a controlled substance and misdemeanor breaking and entering. He received a two-year suspended sentence and was placed on supervised probation for three years.
