says that the average motorist has learned by experience to take proper care of the mechanism of his car, but he too often neglects his tires. Ordinary care accorded spare castings and tubes is good insurance, and will save the motorist both cash and trouble and a few suggestions, therefore, regarding the proper care of tires may benefit the reader.
 For example, never carry spare tubes unprotected in the tool box—they are almost certain to come in contact with sharp tools and perhaps greasy rags, or other greasy articles, all of which are deadly enemies to rubber.
 Exposure to strong light and varying degrees of temperature is also injurious to rubber, robbing it of its elasticity and making it brittle. Always carry spare tubes in the waterproof cloth bags supplied by all accessory dealers for this purpose. Motorists sometimes try to avoid trouble by carrying spare tubes in the original cardboard boxes. Jolting is sure to cause tubes to chafe against the more or less rough inner sides of the boxes, eventually weakening the tubes by wearing away the rubber. Unless inner tubes are stored in the garage they should always be taken from the original boxes and placed in the tube bags already described.
 Recorder's Court At Fuquay
 Fuquay Springs, May 15.—The recorder's court held its May session here yesterday, Judge J. M. Broughton, Jr., presiding. Two criminal cases were disposed of, those being the cases against two negro convicts who assaulted a guard and escaped from the local convict force. Judge Broughton added considerable time to the end of the sentences they are now serving.
