### REPORT OF THE GRAND JURY

To Hon. Geo. W. Connor, Judge Presiding:

We, the Grand Jury, elected to serve at this term, respectfully report to the court:

1st. That we have considered all bills sent to us by the Mayor and have acted upon the same and returned said bills to the Mayor.

2nd. We have considered the report of the County Jail in fair condition, but recommended that the same be painted, new brick and woodwork, and we further recommended that a modern heating plant be provided for the heating of both jail and courthouse. We think that this would be in the interest of both economy and comfort.

3rd. We find that the convict camp is in fair condition.

4th. We recommend that steps be taken for the early enlargement and improvement of the courthouse, and to that end that an architect be employed to draft plans for the enlargement and improvement of the same.

5th. We recommend that a full-time health officer for the county be employed.

6th. We recommend that the Daughters of the Confederacy be requested to open the doors of the Chapter House during the terms of court for the convenience and as a rest room for ladies in attendance of the court until such time as the commissioners by enlargement of the courthouse may provide for this needed comfort for ladies.

7th. We recommend that the toilet in the courthouse be immediately put into servicable and sanitary condition and we also recommend that the toilet on the hillside below the courthouse be replaced by a strictly sanitary toilet, and that a toilet be provided for ladies.

8th. We recommend to the Board of Education that it take immediate steps to comply with all of the sanitary laws with respect to the various schools and schoolhouses in the county.

9th. We recommend that the sanitary laws and health regulations of the State be enforced with respect to hotels in our county, and as a first step we recommend that all hotel and inn keepers be required to have the doors and windows of their respective hotels properly screened.

10th. We recommend that a county road system supplant the present township system, or at least that a county highway commission be appointed to supervise and properly correlate the activities of the several township boards.

11th. We recommend that the railroad crossing at the mill in the edge of the town of Lillington be required to be placed in possible and safe condition, and we recommend that the Board of Commissioners investigate the practicability of having an overhead crossing at the present grade crossing.
