WAYNESVILLE DEFEATS CULLOWHEE 14-0.

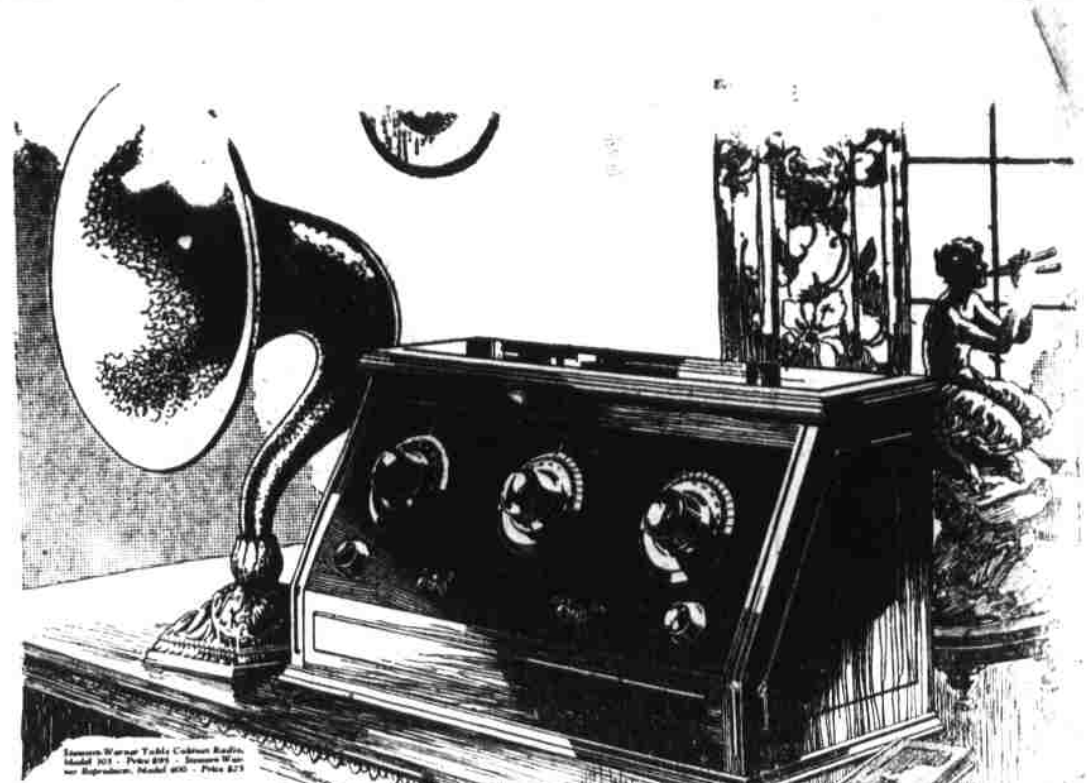

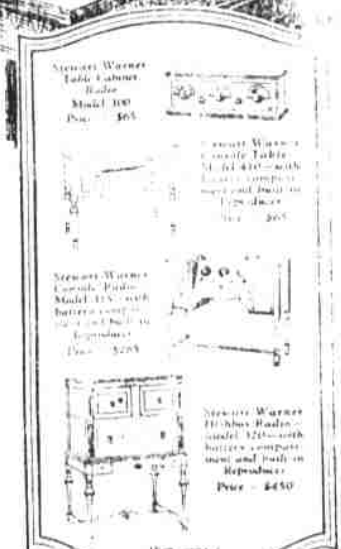
