The said defendants will further take notice that they are required to appear before the Clerk of the Superior Court of Haywood County, North Carolina, at his office in the Court House of said County, in the town of Waynesville, North Carolina, not later than thirty days from the 19th day of August, 1932 and file answer or demurrer to the complaint filed herein, or plaintiff will apply to the Court for the relief demanded in the complaint.
