# Not All Of School **Money Available Used During Year**

#### More Than \$97,000 Returned To State By Counties During Year.

(Special to The Brountaineer.) rivery one of the 100 county superintendents of education in veery one of the 100 counties of North Carolina turned back to the State Board of Equalization some of the money appropriated by the State and made available by that body for use in operation of the six months school term for 1931-32 to the total amount of \$97,306,76, while enough more was returned from the tax reduction, of extended term appropriation, to carry Rathbone, to the undersigned trustee. the amount well above \$100.000. the biennial report of Dr. A. T. Allen. Deeds of Trust Book 17. page 230. State superintendent of public instruction shows.

The amount thus returned to the State, all of which was available for the county superintendents and could have been used without question, was divided between rural and charter schools. The rural schools failed to use the amount appropriated by \$85. 093-67, and the charter schools turned back \$12,213.09 to the State.

Mecklenburg turned back to the State the largest amount, \$7.342.04. more than \$5.000 of which was from the ruarl schools. \$4,032.689.32 for charter schools, and that actual expenditures were \$15.-719,688.93. of which \$11,699.212.70 was in rural and \$4,020.476.23 was in charter schools.
