### NAPHTHALENE FOR WORMS

## Low Grade Feeds Cause Losses In Poultry, it is Said

Most of the dangers of poor nutrition of chickens can be attributed to the use of low grade materials in commercial feeds. It is said that the use of such feeds causes a loss of 25 to 50 per cent of the poultry crop.

Feeds mixed from the best materials, particularly ingredients known to be good chicken food, will not poison the birds.

## Future Farm Loans Will Be Made With Bonds, New Ruling

James H. Allison, secretary-treasurer of the Waynesville National Farm Loan Association, received word today from W. J. Myers, Governor of the Federal Credit Administration, Washington, D. C., that Federal land bank loans and land bank commissioner's loans will be made in the future through the Federal land bank in bonds of the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, which bonds are guaranteed by the United States Government.

The bonds of the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, according to the statement by Governor Myers, will have behind them not only the unconditional guarantee of the Federal Government as to both principal and interest, and the capital of the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation amounting to about \$200,000,000, but also the consolidated bonds of the Federal land banks issued in exchange for the bonds of the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, accepted by the land bank commissioner as security for loans.

Governor Myers issued Secretary Allison that the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation bonds will be an attractive investment. "They will be a readily marketable investment of the United States Government and they will be quoted in all of the principal markets," he said.

## Market For Home-Made Cheese Within State Growing

The increasing demand for North Carolina cheese is expected to result in the production of cheese factories in this State to a new all time record this year, says E. H. Farnham, dairy extension specialist at State College.

North Carolina manufacturers have shown a decided preference for cheese manufactured within the State, he added. In one hour while he was in a North Wilkesboro factory, eight rush orders came in by telephone and telegraph.

In view of the growing demand and the fact that local factories produced only 600,000 pounds of cheese in 1933 as compared with 12,000,000 pounds that had to be purchased from other States, local factories should find the market for their milk expanding rapidly.
