COUNTY AGENT W. D. SMITH'S column

Our bee specialist, Mr. Sams, will be for one day in Haywood county, June 6. Farmers having bees and desiring to know the latest methods and practices in bee keeping should communicate with the County Agent's office at once. We are planning two or three meetings in the county, at the farms of W. P. Rathbone in Fines Creek and Charles McCrary, the hour of these meetings to be announced later.

Mr. Niewanger, State Extension Horticulturist, will spend only two days in the county during the month of June. We will arrange as many meetings as possible and will work with both tomatoes and potatoes. Communities desiring one of these meetings should let us know at once, because we must schedule these meetings within the next few days. All farmers who wish to get their potatoes certified should let the County Agent know at once. Indications are that the amount of certified stock for next season will be small, therefore, those having certified seed can expect reasonable prices. We have every assurance that a modern potato storage house will be available this year. Everyone admits that we can grow good seed potatoes, but our trouble has been that we could not keep the seed over the winter without rotting badly, thereby lowering the sproutiness of our seed.

At last Haywood county has an adequate milk supply to take care of the demands for Grade A and pasteurized milk. It is very gratifying

also that our creamery is turning out enough butter to care for all of our needs in this area. This production is equal to the best production anywhere. New customers are being added daily. But the thing that gratifies us most of all is the money that is going back into the pockets of the farmers of Haywood county. During the last week our creamery paid out to the farmers for milk and cream a total of \$1,100. If we can keep this up every week for the next twelve months it is going to be a great help.

It seems, from the response of our farmers, that they are determined to make this program go and as evidence of this farmers are asking for help in planning their trench silos. Any service the County Agent's office can render, please do not fail to let us know about it. We are listing these calls and will get around just as fast as possible.
