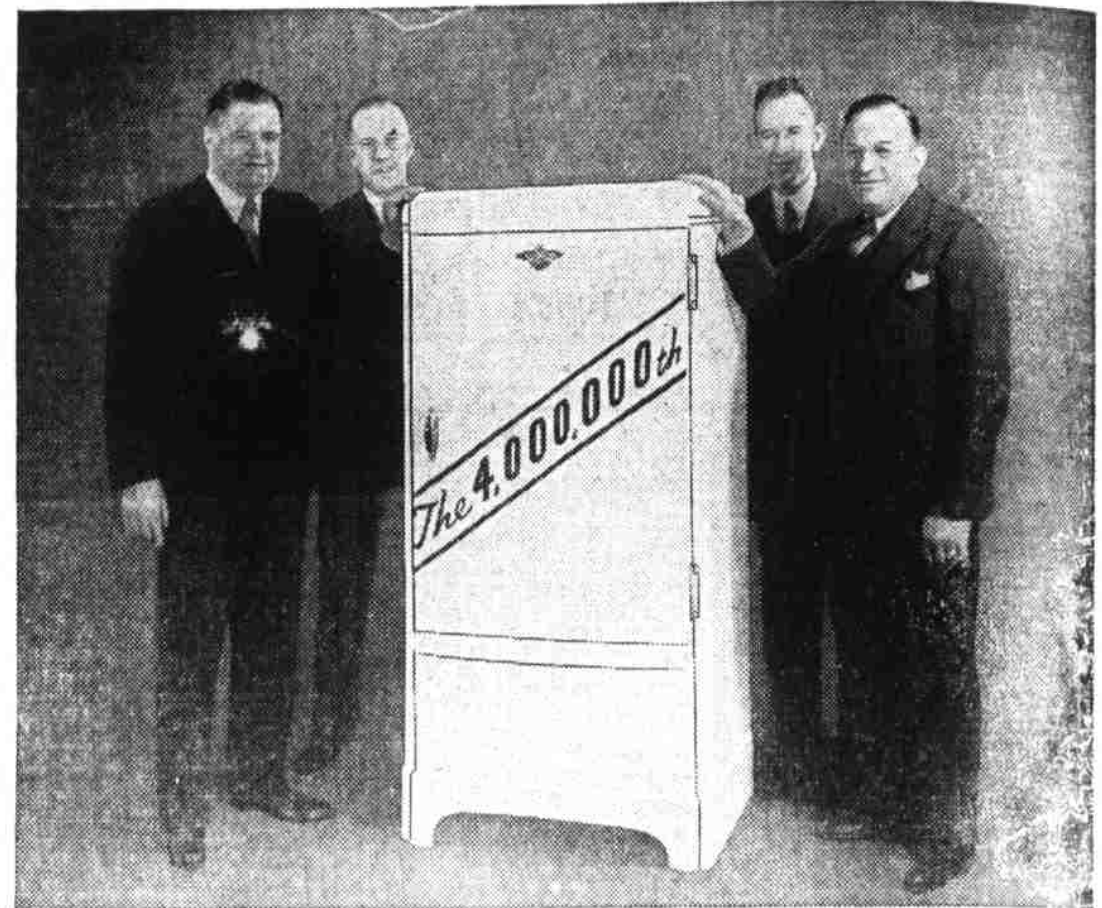
### Pure Oil Company Stages A Banquet

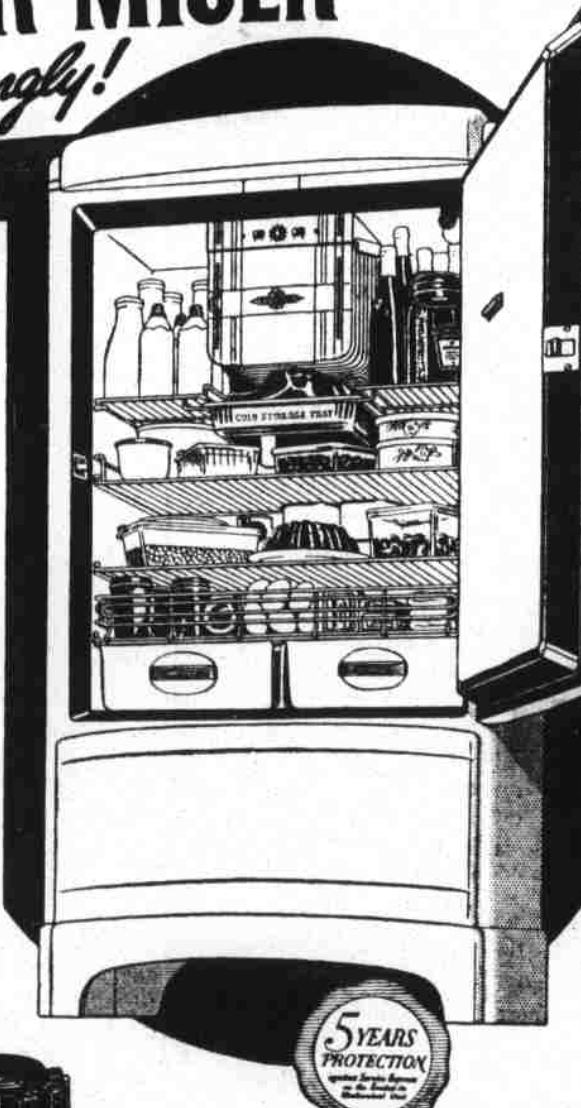
