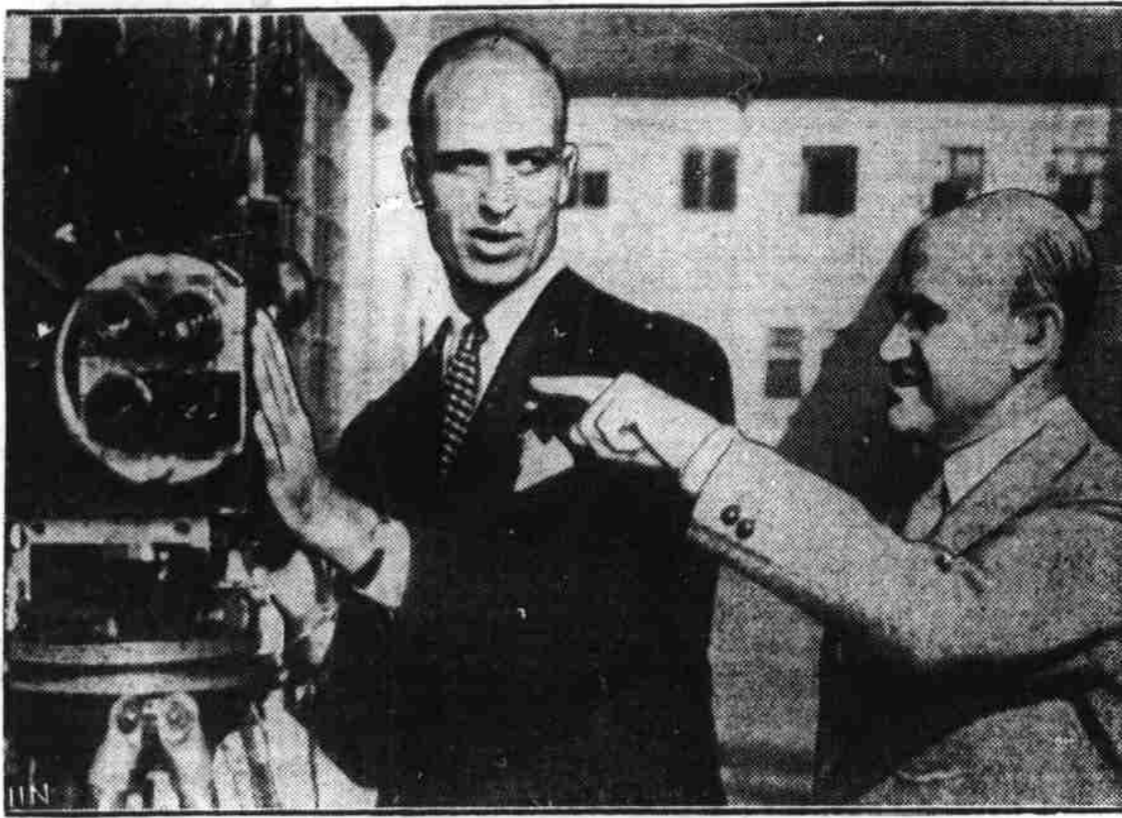


Jimmy Acquaints Himself With New Film Job
