asked to notify the county agent if they are interested in going.

Plans are to make the trip by automobile. The county agent's office is requesting that any person having a car that he can take on the trip, to report it to the office. The tour will include a distance

traveled of 1,100 miles, days and three nights home. The total cost will be \$12.00, which of all expenses.
